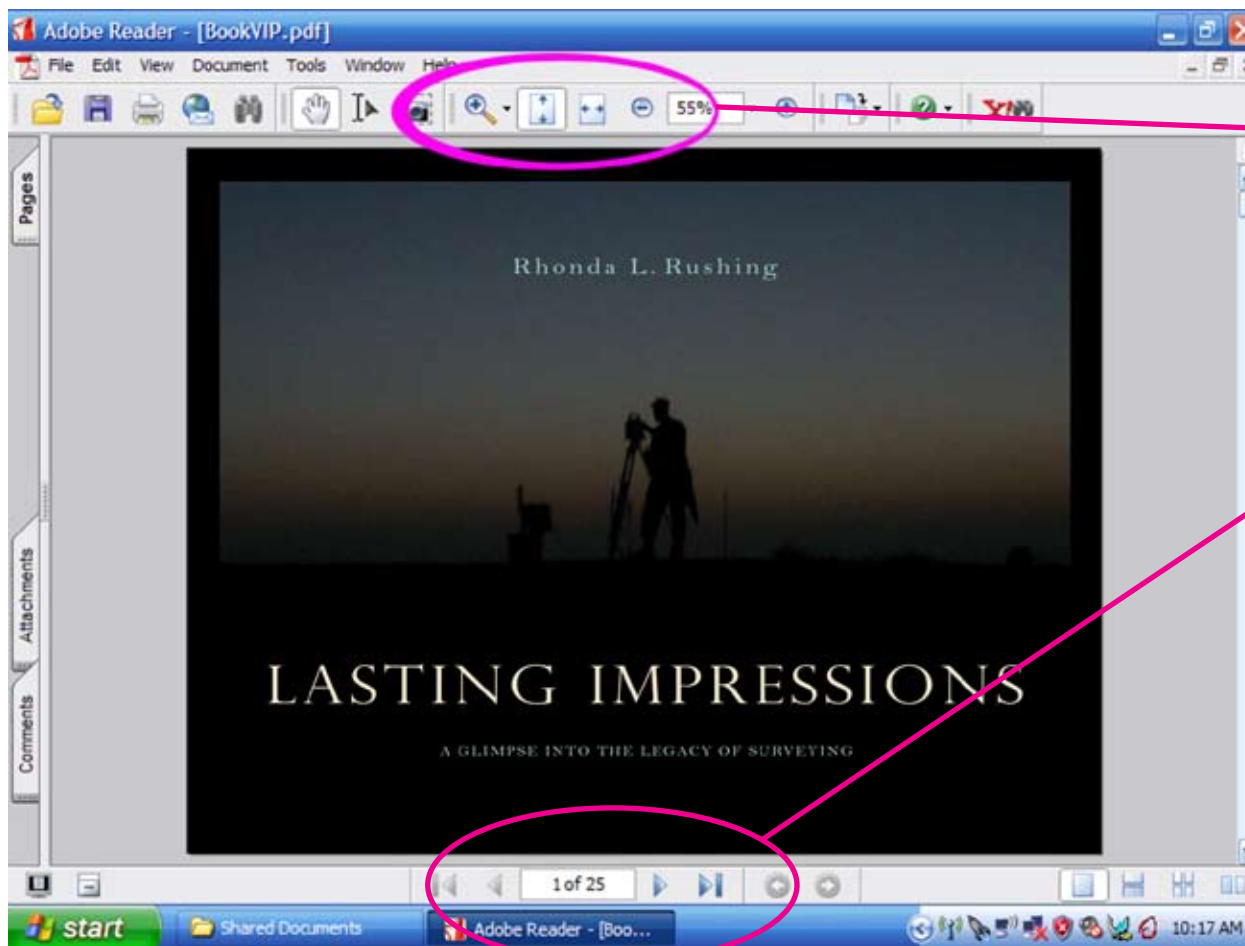


LASTING IMPRESSIONS

A SAMPLE OF ON THE WRONG BORDER



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LATITUDE, LONGITUDE

North Latitude: 39° 20' 20"

West Longitude: 110° 23' .07"



ON THE WRONG BORDER

This is a four-inch brass cap set on a three and a half-inch pipe, and is unique because this monument was intended for work done on the U.S. and Canadian Border, but is in fact positioned on a level run in Emery County, Utah. This monument was set in 1910 on a level run by L.F. Biggs for the U.S. Geological Survey. This information can be found in U.S.G.S. Bulletin 566, "Results of Spirit Leveling In Utah 1897-1914, Inclusive."

This monument was included in the NGS database through leveling in 1934 and has NGS PID: KN0030. It is located approximately 30 miles north of Green River, Utah, along State Route 6; then approximately 0.6 miles Southwest along Silvangni Ranch Road and just beyond an active railroad crossing. The monument must be reached by walking up the east side of the Railroad R/W or by crossing over the R/W from the road on the west side of the tracks. It can be found at 39°20'20" North latitude and 110°23'07" West longitude.
